Nikolai Totev is an artist who does not fit in any borders and is far from academic painting. He is not "normal" type of artist he is one of the few in Bulgaria to paint "Art Brut" - a style known as "Outsider Art." The term was created by French artist Jean Dubuffet in 1945 and is associated with type of work that has since received wide recognition in the art world.

Works of Nikolai Totev are owned by world famous museums and galleries and private collections in the Netherlands, Luxembourg, France, Japan, Belgium, and its name is the character of European culture.

The film is the last shooting of the great Bulgarian archaeologist Dr. Georgi Kitov. He talks about his findings, some discoveries and observations made during his long career of research on field. The film reveals many mysteries of Thracian culture, their magic rituals and symbolism embedded in the golden treasures.

The film was honored with 5 prestigious awards at international festivals, including the Prize of Europe of the International Archaeological Film Festival - Besancon, France / 2009 /.
